Thijs continues to champion models that prioritize trust, autonomy, and meaningful relationships in both healthcare and housing.
- Klaas Ariaans will share his self-organization journey at ABN Amro. As the former Director of Personal Banking at ABN AMRO, Klaas led a groundbreaking transformation by reducing the number of managers from 278 to 25 in a single day and transitioning 3,500 employees into self-organizing teams. This bold move empowered employees, reduced bureaucracy, and enhanced customer service, resulting in increased customer satisfaction, higher employee engagement, and significant cost savings.



- Be inspired by Ruben Timmerman, founder of self-managing company Springest, Europe's largest comparison platform for training and education, and a popular learning platform for major organizations. After selling Springest, he joined Rutger Bregman's School of Moral Ambition as People & Tech Lead. Passionate about driving change, Ruben helps individuals and organizations transform from within to create greater external impact. He advocates for self-management and consciousness-driven leadership. As an investor, Ruben supports 17 startups, funds, and charities dedicated to solving the climate crisis and structurally improving society, aligning his work with a vision for a more sustainable and equitable world.
- Meet Martijn Pater, serial impact entrepreneur and founder of Fronteer, a boutique strategy and innovation firm known for pioneering co-creation methodologies globally. Fronteer operates as a self-managing company based on holacratic principles, fostering a culture of collaboration and autonomy. Martijn has helped organizations tackle complex challenges through innovative, purpose-driven strategies. He's coauthor of Collaborate or Die, the changemaker's handbook on co-creation. In addition to his work at Fronteer, Martijn co-founded Coding the Curbs, a venture focused on digital loading zones, and serves as chairman of NDSM Energie, a local energy initiative. Both projects aim to create livable and sustainable cities, reflecting his commitment to social and environmental impact.
